Week 1: COKER COLLEGE

Coker College is located in lovely Hartsville, SC. At Coker, the emphasis is on the individual, and the summer curriculum is modeled after Coker's renowned liberal arts program. Choose one of the following courses to study for the week: Graphic Design; Criminology; Psychology; Creative Writing; Game Design; or Business & Entrepreneurship. During the program, students will take a road trip to nearby **Charleston** to spend a day at the beach or explore the beautiful downtown area.



Overnighter: Washington, D.C.

At the conclusion of the Coker programs, Cruise participants will board a charter bus and be whisked away to Washington, D.C., where they will spend the night after visiting some of the city's best museums.

Week 2: STONEHILL COLLEGE

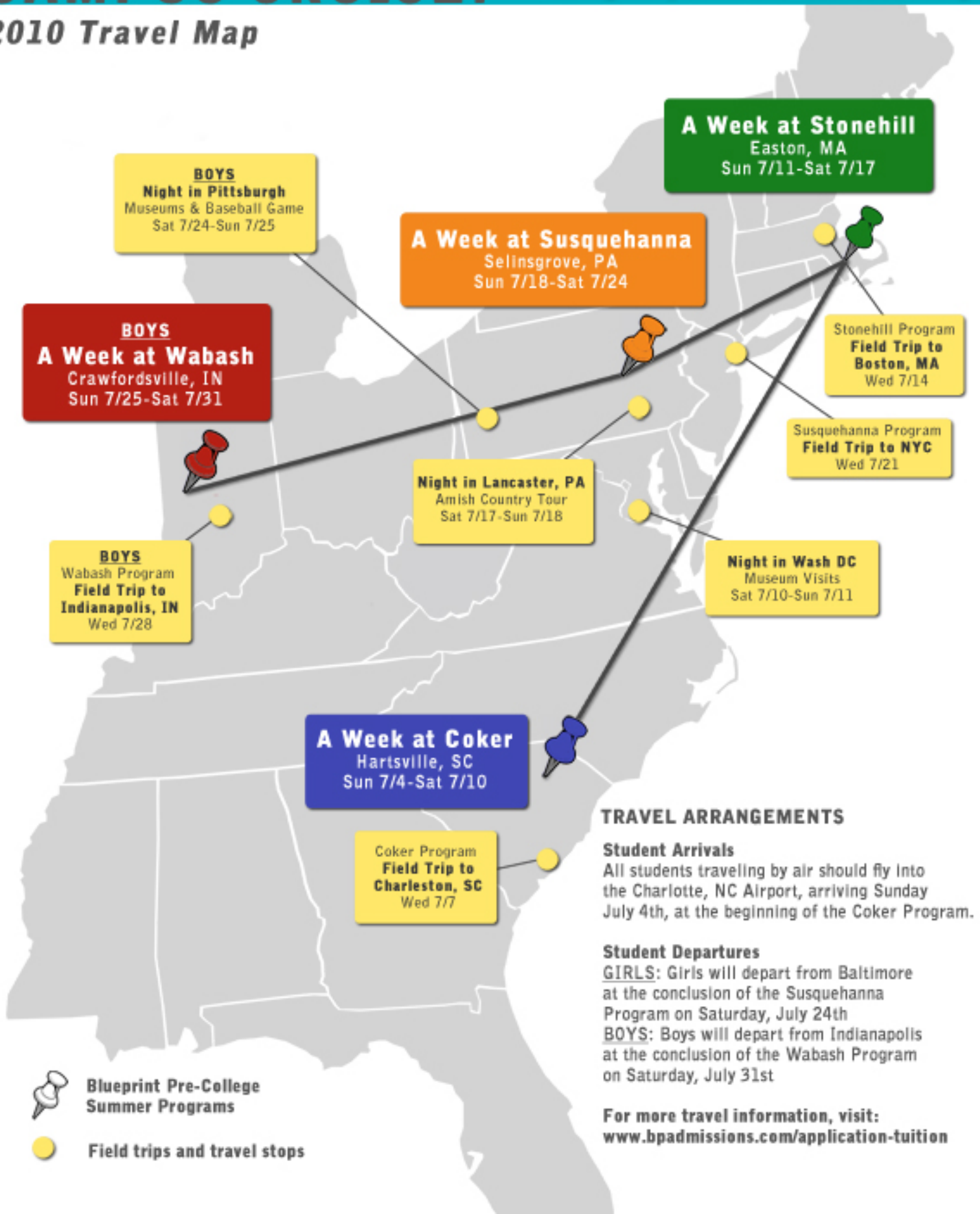
